**WHERE THE JOBS ARE 2009 REPORT RELEASE SLATED FOR THURS, SEPT 3;
REVEALS FEDERAL GOVERNMENT MUST HIRE TENS OF THOUSANDS OF NEW
WORKERS TO FILL MISSION-CRITICAL JOBS**

WASHINGTON – Great news for job seekers this Labor Day: the federal government is hiring tens of thousands of new employees according to a report to be released on Thursday, September 3 by the Partnership for Public Service. Based on a survey of 35 federal agencies representing nearly 99 percent of the 1.9 million federal workforce, *Where the Jobs Are 2009: Mission-Critical Opportunities for America* outlines government-wide projected hiring needs for the next three years.

Find out which occupations top Uncle Sam's most-wanted list this Labor Day, where these jobs are located, and what's driving the government's hiring surge. Plus, learn tips on how to navigate the federal hiring process and land a dream job where you can make a difference and improve the lives of Americans.
