



# Delivering Outcomes with Communities

The Partnership's Delivering Outcomes with Communities course provides federal staff whose agencies work in diverse communities with the skills, resources and new perspectives to improve community outcomes.

This course is for federal staff and managers working in headquarters or field offices, who address economic and social challenges faced by communities across the U.S. Participants in the training will enhance their ability to:

- **NAVIGATE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT**  
Use high-value resources across the federal government and create cross-agency partnerships that leverage these resources;
- **NAVIGATE LOCAL COMMUNITIES**  
Understand how local communities and partners operate; gain insight into local government structures, stakeholders, resources and networks; and know how to leverage these community assets to improve outcomes; and
- **PARTNER EFFECTIVELY**  
Partner effectively with community stakeholders to drive positive results.

## PROGRAM DATES

**November 30–December 2, 2016**

Training takes place at the Partnership for Public Service in Washington, DC and includes site visits to community partners

## COST AND APPLICATION

The cost of the three-day training is \$1,100. Tuition is due November 25, 2016.

Applications are accepted on a rolling basis until October 28. Should capacity be reached prior to the enrollment deadline, subsequent applicants will be waitlisted.
