



Call to Serve Internship Program

Our nation faces many critical and complex challenges. Meeting these challenges requires new, innovative solutions from our federal government. The Call to Serve Innovation Internship program offers civic-minded undergraduate students at George Washington University the opportunity to experience federal service firsthand and contribute to developing creative solutions to meet the needs of the public.

Placement opportunities may be located in federal innovation centers and labs within federal agencies, such as US Agency for International Development, Office of Personnel Management and Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services.

Students selected for this program will spend the Summer 2021 term in a federal agency working on an innovation-focused portfolio, benefitting from:

- Challenging work, which includes utilizing proven innovative practices to advance the agency's mission and improve the lives of the American people
- A network of fellow interns and federal innovation leaders across the government
- Professional development opportunities to gain and improve leadership skills
- A stipend amount of \$5,000 to cover costs in order to participate in the program

ELIGIBILITY

In order to be eligible for this program, all applicants must meet the following criteria:

- U.S. Citizenship
- Current enrollment in an undergraduate program at George Washington University, with at least one semester remaining
- Overall GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Demonstrated commitment to public service and interest in learning new approaches to complex challenges

All majors are welcome to apply. Students with a demonstrated interest in innovation, communications, international relations or business are particularly encouraged to apply.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- Resume
- Most recent transcript (transcript should include verification of GPA and classes taken. Unofficial transcripts are accepted)

Applications will be open from **February 1 to March 5, 2021**.
