DeJonge Schulman also served on the National Security Council during the Obama administration and in senior staff roles at the Department of Defense. She is widely published, the co-host of the national security podcast, “Bombshell” and a senior editor at War on the Rocks, a forum for analysis, commentary and debate on foreign policy and national security issues.

“Empowering our government with the ideas, connections and people necessary to take on tomorrow’s challenges is both urgent and a remarkable privilege,” said DeJonge Schulman. “I am delighted to join the incredible team at the Partnership and to be a part of their efforts strengthening American democratic institutions.”
