The Leadership Excellence for Acquisition Professionals Program, designed for GS-12 to GS-14 government acquisition employees, prepares these mission-critical professionals to become better leaders by focusing on the four core tenets of the Partnership's Public Service Leadership Model—self-awareness, engaging others, leading change and achieving results. By the end of the course, participants are able to make values-based decisions, use their roles to build strong partnerships, identify how to drive positive impact within their organizations and demonstrate enhanced leadership attributes.

APPLICATION CRITERIA

Completed applications must include:

- Personal information.
- Professional experience.
- Developmental goals for the program.
- Supervisor endorsement a link to the endorsement form is in the application

Applicants should write short-answer responses that demonstrate how their career goals align with the expectations of the LEAP program.

Program content is geared toward individuals with leadership experience who seek positions or roles of increased responsibility. We have high standards for all participants and evaluate their applications to ensure they will be able to contribute fully to the program.

Applicants can save their application and return to it at any time.



WHO SHOULD APPLY

Enrollment is open to high-performing acquisition professionals who have reached the GS-12 to GS-14 level at the time of application. At minimum, participants should have at least three years of contracting experience and possess a FAC-C Level II or equivalent certification. To meet their guidelines, agencies may raise the level of qualifications.



LOCATION AND TIME COMMITMENT

All sessions will take place virtually from 10:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Eastern Time using the Zoom for Government platform. During the program, participants remain in their full-time jobs and meet every month, spending a total of 15 days in session, and devote three to five hours per week on session pre-work and group meetings. Participants are expected to attend all sessions, so applicants should review the class schedule and confirm their availability before applying to the program. Exceptions are made for family and work-related emergencies.
